

Suggested questions to ask at a Project Presentation

Please ask any questions that you feel are most relevant for the presentation you are observing.

Please use the opportunity to extract information or confirm things that need consolidating.

Below are some suggested generic questions that could be used.

1. What have you found the most challenging part of your project?
2. Did you find enough sources to help you - internet? books? journals? people?
3. Which sources were the most useful and why?
4. Did you reject any sources? If so why? (biased? Wikipedia?)
5. Was it easy to stick to your project title?
6. Did you fulfill your original aims and objectives?
7. If you started again - what would you do differently?
8. What decisions did you make during your project?
9. Would you choose the same project again? - explain.
10. Do you think a more detailed plan would have helped you?
11. Did you find it easy to manage your time?
12. What skills have you developed through doing your project? - give examples.
13. Has your project had any influence on your career plans? If so, in what way?
14. Did you have any ethical issues to consider? If so what were they?
